- ◆ Completion of following courses with grade C or better:
 ENG 1003, ENG 1013, MATH 1023, COMS 1203, TE 2003
- ◆ ACT Super Score Composite \geq 20, Reading & Math \geq 19, Writing \geq 7
 or Praxis CORE Reading/Math \geq 162, Writing \geq 165 ***
- ◆ Completion of Career Awareness Inventory (Counseling Center)
- ◆ Completion of Application for Admission with all required documentation (completed with academic advisor)
- ◆ Make an appointment for and successfully complete department screening interview
