**Subject: Student Refunds** 

- Any student who officially withdraws from the University during an enrollment period may be entitled to a percentage refund of tuition, room and board, and some fees and deposits, according to guidelines in the undergraduate and graduate catalogs, with the exception of parking permit fees.
- 2. Any student who officially withdraws from a course but remains enrolled in other courses may be entitled to a tuition refund based on the refund schedule in the general bulletin.
- A student is entitled to a full tuition refund if a course is cancelled by the University. Additionally, a student whose course is cancelled and who is registered only for that course is entitled to a full refund of all other fees or deposits charged in conjunction with that enrollment period.
- 4. Students eligible for refunds should contact the Treasurer's Office either by telephone at (870) 972-2285 or in person.

## **PROCEDURES**

## Refunds - Withdrawal from the University

Students must withdraw from the University through Wilson Advising Center and request a refund through the Treasurer's Office.

## Refunds - Dropping a class

Students can drop a course online or manually with the Registrar's Office (with appropriate documentation). Refunds are processed based on the following schedule:

#### **REGULATIONS**

## <u>General</u>

- 1. The student should request a refund by email or in person at the Treasurer's Office.
- 2. Refunds for withdrawals are based on the date of withdrawal, not class attendance.
- 3. Refunds for dropped courses are based on the drop date.
- 4. Generally, no refund check is processed until fourteen (14) working days after payment to allow time for the check to clear a financial institution.
- 5. Credit card payment refunds are credited back to the card and not refunded to the student.

# Refunds - Special Fees

- 1. Large Scale Distance Education program 15-week courses receive a 100% refund through the fifth day of class and 75% through the sixth to tenth day of class. Courses on a 5-week or 7-week schedule receive a 100% refund through the second day of class and 75% through the third and fourth day of class. See Tuition Rates and Rules below.
- 2. The Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Management course supply fee is nonrefundable.
